

Plant Survival



This project teaches children about the growth of plants from seeds and bulbs. They observe the growth of plants firsthand, recording changes over time and identifying what plants need to grow and stay healthy.

- Plant parts;
- Seasonal changes in plants;
- Investigating germination;
- Investigating plant growth; Unusual plants;
- Working scientifically – Observing changes over time, Identifying and classifying, Pattern seeking, Comparative test, Research

In the Plant Survival project, children will learn the names of the different parts of a plant and how they grow. They observe how the seasonal changes affect how plants grow. They will learn how new plants can grow from seeds and bulbs and what they need to germinate. They will use their observational skills to find out where plants like to grow and investigate what plants need to grow and stay healthy. Children will then use their research skills to find out about some unusual plants.
